On Sunday 12th August Meg Ryan from Balanced Paws came to club to give a session on Canine Body Language to committee members and instructors.

—————— This was an insightful session held by Meg to help educate us in keeping a dog under threshold which allows them to be more receptive during training. High arousal levels will often turn to aggression, as they are really just different sides to the same coin. A precursor to arousal, is often signs of stress.

The aim for the day was to make people aware on how to notice early when a dog is showing signs of stress. The earlier it is noticed the easier it will be to calm them down.

(Normal start class time)


Rodney from KONG along with his dogs will be coming to EGDOC for some action packed fun!!!

Another super busy month for this dynamic duo. On Sunday 12th August they headed off to compete at the Inverleigh tracking trial. They passed Tracking Test 6 to gain Hansel's TDX (Tracking dog excellent) title, under judge Lynn Klecka.

The on Sunday 26th August Hansel passed his
Tracking Test 7 at Inverleigh under judge Gary Fainges.
This test involves tracking an unknown person for
1200 metres. It includes at least six changes of
direction including two acute turns, plus the dog must
find two out of the three dropped articles.

Also on Sunday 26th August at the Dogs Victoria State Trial cash passed his test 5 with a grading of Very Good.

Test 5 is approx. 1km aged with 3 articles of which the dog must find at 2 and the tracklayer. Also the track is deliberately crossed over by a second person whose scent the dog must ignore and continue tracking the scent from the start of the track.

They were also awarded the judges encouragement award for the day for handling .

Cash is entered for test 6 at Ballarat in a couple of weeks. If he passes he will gain his Tracking Dog Excellent Title.


